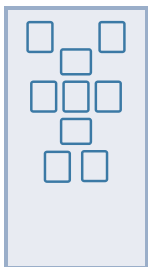


# TEMPERATURE MANAGEMENT BLANKETS

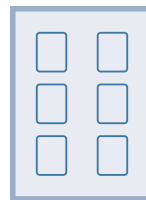


### Full Body Blanket
